Breakfast and lunch will be available at three satellite locations, beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020. **Any family** in the Clifton Public Schools Community can pick-up grab and go breakfast and/or lunch from 10 am to 11 am, Monday through Friday, at CHS, CCMS, and School 17. Meal pick up will be at specific door locations.

CHS -----Gym doors at the front of the building  
CCMS-----Cafeteria Doors alongside the Stadium  
School 17---- Cafeteria doors in front of the building

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All staff, students and administrators should report to school on Monday, March 16th, for a regular school day. All afterschool activities inclusive of in-school and offsite agencies activities/programs are cancelled.

At the end of school day, packets for home instruction will be distributed for students to use while the **district is closed from Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>**. Schools will reopen on Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. Students **MUST** pick up their instructional packets and turn them in on April 1<sup>st</sup> in order to get credit and to receive a grade for the days schools are closed.

For any students who cannot pick up their home instruction packets on Monday, administrators will be at schools on Tuesday, March 17th and will have packets available for students.

Food distribution will begin on Tuesday, March 17th.

Breakfast and lunch will be provided from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. There will be two food distribution sites in each of the City of Paterson’s six wards. Students and parents should go to the distribution location closest to their residence. Depending on the number within the household, it is recommended for parent/guardians to bring a tote bag to carry meals.
